DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.

Hold container 6-8 inches from skin or clothing and spray with a slow, sweeping motion. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Do not spray directly on face. If used on the face, spray on hands first, then apply sparingly to face and ears. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Avoid overapplication. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Do not apply to children's hands.

 Works on clothing, too: Spray shirts, pants and hats. For ticks, chiggers and fleas, apply to tops of socks and around openings of outer clothing.

After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place, out of reach of children.
